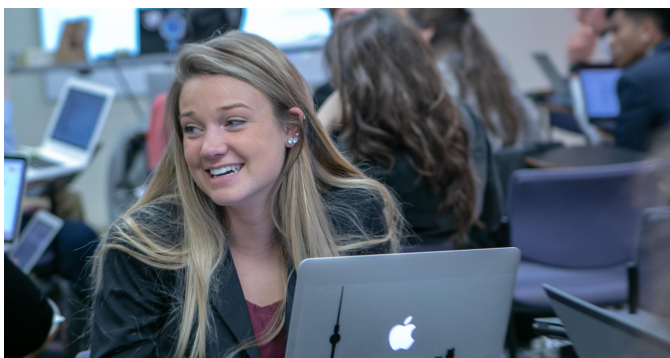
Invest in Communities
