Virtual Enterprises International (VE) is a national nonprofit that transforms students through authentic business experiences which prepare them for fulfilling, financially secure futures. Since its inception in 1996, VE has served over 200,000 high school students, including many from underserved communities. In 2015, VE introduced the VE-Junior Ventures Career Academy, a two-year middle-school program that enables 7th and 8th grade students to develop technology and entrepreneurial skills by starting and managing business ventures.

VE students interact with business professionals who mentor them regularly, and 87% identify a career path of interest due to their involvement in the VE program. We currently support 20,000 students across the U.S. each year and are part of a global network spanning 40 countries and 7,000 student-run businesses.

NATIONAL BUSINESS PLAN COMPETITION

Teams representing VE companies from around the country will have their written business plans and oral presentations judged by industry professionals. After receiving top honors in local and regional business plan competitions during the school year, these teams have earned the chance to compete in the country's premiere team-based national business plan competition.

NATIONAL COMPETITIONS: FINANCE / HUMAN RESOURCES / MARKETING / QUICKBOOKS

Teams of one-to-four department employees from VE companies deliver oral presentations to inform judges of their department policies and practices as they relate to the strategies, operations, and deliverables for their respective departments.

GLOBAL INNOVATION CHALLENGE (ONLINE)

The Global Innovation Challenge is one of the world's most unique business-related events for high school students. Students representing different countries work in multinational teams to solve a pressing global issue using design thinking principles.

In preparation of the Global Innovation Challenge, multinational teams of students met and collaborated online in February, March, and April. Students worked with mentors who coached them on strategies to address the problem and develop a slide show, which will be presented to judges.

BUSINESS SHOWCASE/TRADE SHOW

The Business Showcase/Trade Show is VE's most dynamic live event as well as the largest exhibition of practice businesses in the U.S. The event brings together thousands of students from around the world who exhibit and sell the products and services of their VE businesses in a competitive marketplace, network with other VE students and business professionals, and garner real-world feedback from customers and guests.

VE-JV NATIONAL BUSINESS PITCH COMPETITION

The VE-JV National Business Pitch Competition is an amazing opportunity for middle school students to pitch their business concept to a judging panel of industry professionals.

SEMIFINAL ROUND: The Top 20 teams will present from 1:00 PM - 3:00 PM ET in presentation rooms with no other teams viewing presentations. The Top 8 teams will be announced at 3:30 PM ET in Shanker Hall B - 2nd Floor and an email notification will also be sent to facilitators.

CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND: The Top 8 teams will present in an open area with other teams viewing the presentations. Announcements of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be made during the Business Showcase/Trade Show on Wednesday, April 6 at 9:30 AM ET.

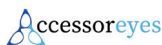

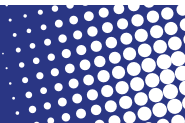
