

VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

VOLUNTEER ROLES

Both virtual and in-person opportunities are available.

Judge

Judges provide industry insight and real-world business feedback on competitions. They review student work submitted through VE's judging platform and/or participate in a video conference/in-person event in which students present their work to a panel of professionals. Judges score teams based on a provided rubric and share suggestions for improvements.

Trade Show Guest Shopper

Trade Show Guest Shoppers support youth by engaging them beyond the classroom in authentic business transactions. They participate as "guest shoppers" in the trade show and are provided with a VE credit card that can be used to make "purchases" from VE firms. Guest Shoppers engage in discussions with students about their companies and products and service offerings. *Note: No real money or products/services are exchanged.*

Mentor

Mentors can serve as an individual or as part of a company volunteer team. Mentors act as "business consultants" for a VE firm and help students enhance their business plans while supporting the marketing, finance, and human resources departments within the VE firm.

For each event, volunteers spend an average of 30-60 minutes.

- Dependable and punctual
- Courteous and personable
- Self-directed, willing to take initiative, and detail-oriented
- Respectful of VE's students, volunteers, partners, and donors, maintaining confidentiality as appropriate
